At the heart of this economic transition is the entrepreneurial action. In today's scenario, economy Tamil Nadu is leaving its entrepreneurial footprints all over the world.

Tamil Nadu Student Innovators Programme is an initiative of EDII-TN to encourage student innovators/entrepreneurs from all over Tamil Nadu. TNSI was introduced in 2017 and organized region-wise across Tamil Nadu. The student teams are provided opportunity to give their innovative ideas as a solution to identified validated problem statements in the field of agriculture, industry, smart cities, health care, fintech and automobile sectors.

The programme includes series of events like awareness and ideation programmes, boot camps and final pitch. Innovative ideas are selected by a panel of Jury from the Startup Ecosystem for the award of Rs. 1.00 lakh each for further development of their prototype and also to commercialise the product. They are also been introduced to angel investors who are ready to adopt and invest in their startups.

Tamil Nadu Entrepreneurship Development and Innovation Institute, Tamil Nadu (EDII-TN) strongly emphasized the role of education in catalyzing Entrepreneurship. Though entrepreneurship forms an important subject in Science & Technology studies, whether in polytechnic, engineering and now school education, it does not form a substantial part of the curriculum. Time and again question that is raised on to How is it that the students of Science & Technology seldom take the entrepreneurship and while studies offer knowledge and skills, there is very less opportunity to learning the process of becoming entrepreneurs.

With a view to create awareness among teacher, faculty and students of Engineering about various facets of entrepreneurship as an alternative career option a "Boot Camp on Innovation and Development Projects" is held at V V College of Engineering, Tisaiyanvilai. This program is jointly organized by EDII-TN and Anna University Regional Campus Tirunelveli - IEDP hub.The aim of the three days regional level boot camp is to make students aware about aspects of Innovation projects and its development as well as Entrepreneurship. Students are made to face the situations similar to the problems faced by practical real life entrepreneurs, and help students to find proper solution to overcome the difficulty.

This would help students to overcome mental pressure in their academic as well as practical life. Apart from the problem solutions, they also learn how to make plans related to business and aware about market surveys about their idea. Hence, this regional level bootcamp helps a student to develop an entrepreneurial mind and learn how real life setup of ideas takes place. Three days regional level Boot-Camp is an Innovation projects competition for students of various colleges from four districts Tirunelveli, Thoothukudi, Kanniyakumari and Tenkasi. On the first day of camp, participants are made familiar with different aspects of innovation projects and entrepreneurship.




The program began with the inaugural function on 4th February, 2023 at about 9:30 A.M.



Presentation by Mr.Ramkumar, MEPCO


In the second day morning, a training was given on the most essential topic Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) by Mr.Mr.R.Arun Kumar, Patent Agent and Master Trainer, EDII-TN and also a Certified ILO Trainer. He explained about the types of IPR, need for obtaining patents, benefit of obtaining patents with real life examples. He also explained about trademarks, trade secrets, Copyrights, Licensing, geographic Indications etc.

He insisted that Intellectual property rights are the rights given to persons over the creations of their minds. They usually give the creator an exclusive right over the use of his/her creation for a certain period of time.Additionally, he is one among the 21 patent agents in India. He taught students how to apply for patents, how to fill the application form. This session was very useful Staff members also. Students felt the session very useful. They enquired and cleared their doubts regarding how they could convert their inventions into patents

The chief guest Mr.Dheebin, Founder and Manager of Kumari shoppy listened to all the new inventions.






















VALEDICTORY FUNCTION
